
Mission Implementation Framework

Mission


Mission is the goal an organization sets to achieve in its journey.



For example - The societal mission of EkStep is to improve literacy and numeracy by increasing access to learning opportunities for 200 million children of India by 2020.


Mission

The mission is operationalised through a number of programmes




Programme

A **programme** is a set of planned activities with predefined goals and objectives.



Programme


For Example -DIKSHA (Digital Infrastructure for Knowledge Sharing), a programme by the Ministry of Human Resources Development and National Council for Teacher Education(MHRD), focuses on providing an enhanced digital learning experience for teachers and learners.



Programme


Some of the programme objectives include:

The programme incorporates several **solutions** to achieve the objectives. All the objectives, put together, address a set of problems.






Equipping textbooks with QR codes which will have e-learning content linked to the curriculum

Solution

Creation of solutions is possible through two approaches.




develop solutions directly in response to a specific problem

OR

have solution environments that invite civil society, state and market in resolving the problems in their own, local and ingenious ways

Solution Environment


Solution environments enable the creation of solutions by providing collaborative workspaces where the participating actors (civil society, state and market) are exposed to various resources.



Asset

To provide the capability to develop solutions or power up the solution, resources need to be organised and leveraged. These resources are called assets.


An **asset** is a valuable resource that can be used to provide future benefits.


Assets can be of various types.
